Carlos Alonso González, "Santillana". Was born in (Santillana del Mar, August 23, 1952) from here, his population comes his nickname of Santillana. It is one of the best and the most charismatic players of Real Madrid. He was an excellent forward and one of the best headers of the history of football.

Biography:

When he was young, he studied in the college of the Fathers Escolapios of Villacarriedo in Cantabria.

When he was a child, he was playing in Satellite Barreda.

Then he went to Racing de Santander. In the season 1970/1971

Real Madrid signed him at age of 19, in this club he won:

- 9 Spanish leagues: 1971-72, 1974-75, 1975-76, 1977-78, 1978-79, 1979-80, 1985-86, 1988-89.
- 2 cups of the Generalissimo: 1973-74, 1974-75.
- 2 cups of the King: 1979-80, 1981-82.
- 2 UEFA. : 1984-85, 1985-86.

In the white club is remembered as the star of the nine leagues, as in the matches that he played against Internazionale of Milan and the leadership that he imposed at the end of his sporting career when he was the captain. His last game was played against Valladolid in 1988 where he got his final goal and this goal was with the head.

Spanish team:

He debuted with the red on April 17, 1975 against Romania where the game ended with 1-1.

In the selection he did 15 goals in 56 matches, participating in two championship of the world, Argentina 1978 and Spain 1982. And in the Eurocup of 1984 in France, where the selection lost 2-0 in the final against France with a failure of Arconada, the goalkeeper of Spain that is remembered for this. To reach this year's Eurocup Spain had to win 12-1 to Malta, where Santillana did 4 goals.

Only Manolo Sanchis has passed him in games played with the white shirt of Real Madrid.

Currently he is an employer and he sells sports clothes to its customers.
